This past year has certainly been unique, and even though it has offered us many challenges, it has also provided great opportunities. We would like to take a moment to say thank you to each and every one who has given to [Partners in Hope Tanzania](#). In light of COVID-19, there were some unique opportunities to give. We placed the need before you and together ~\$36,000 was raised, making a HUGE difference in the lives of the Mwalwigi community.



Back in March 2020, the pandemic hit Mwalwigi village and the school complex which houses over 200 Albino children. The government did not have funds to feed the children, so Pastor Titus told us about the need. We asked for help and you responded. Food was provided for these forgotten ones for almost 4 months.



During the lockdown, it was discovered that many of the children didn't have a blanket, many didn't even have a proper bed or mattress to sleep on. This became our next opportunity to give assistance.

Through directly asking, along with the fundraisers & awareness events "Riddle Rally" and "Alone in the woods challenges", and a GoFundMe page, we were able to gather enough money to buy 200 blankets, 45 bunkbeds, 40 mattresses, 150 pillows and 100 mosquito nets. These items were delivered to the children at the end of 2020. Please know what an incredible difference this has made in their everyday lives. It gives such peace knowing that these kids now have a warm, dry, and safe place to lay their head at night.

Donors were so generous that in addition to the food, and the bed sets, there were enough funds to purchase two acres of land. Additionally, a private donation was given to buy 8 MORE acres of land. These 10 acres of land will be used to grow nutritious vegetables for the Albino kids, along with the local orphans and widows. We just love that this sustainable solution is part of the ministry now.



Donations continued to come in, including funds to host the annual Christmas conference for 250 children. The conference began and ended abruptly due to COVID-19 school closures BUT the food was put to good use, for the albino children who remained living in protective custody at the school. Soccer balls and other items bought for the conference were so appreciated by these children.



This past year has also allowed us to give supplies to help the widows during COVID-19, purchase bicycles for ministry use, and extra school supplies for the children. Donations also came in directed towards purchasing Bibles and hymnals for the church, as well as a donation to pay for a hydrological well survey.

So again, thank-you for your part in all of this!

So what are the hopes and prayers of Partners in Hope Tanzania for 2021?

To drill a well!! which would:

- Eliminate the need for women and children to make the 5-7 km trek to a muddy crocodile-infested pond;
- Reduce all the water borne diseases that take lives and cause so much sickness;
- Provide a watering system for the 10 acres of land that was purchased for the community; and
- Provide refreshment with the basic need of clean, drinkable water!



The process of an important hydrological study is now underway (also thanks to a directed donation) & once a good location to drill for the water is determined, we will need the rest of the funds to make it happen.
