We wanted to send you a 'good news' follow-up on the sad email sent to you last week of how the young albino children were mutilated. It was very hard to read, and even harder to look at their pictures. What remains to be sad is that these young lives have been forever changed. Not only have they lost limbs, they have lost their homes, their families and their freedom because it isn't safe for them to live outside of protective custody.

For those of you who forwarded that email on to your contacts, please provide them with this update.

The children are currently in hospital receiving further treatments for their injuries, as well as receiving help for the mental trauma they've experienced. Pastor Titus has been to see them, and he shared: *"The children are doing quite well although they still have a lot of physical and mental pain. They need our prayers and encouragement as they feel as if their presence is no longer valuable in this world. Their hearts have been broken and they are desperate"* 

Such a sad statement from young innocent victims.

We asked you for any kind of help that you could possibly give, and praise God, you answered!!! The medical bills for the children are currently up to date. Although there may be ongoing needs with the amputations.

Also, we told you that we needed over \$6000. to provide beds, mattresses, pillows, blankets and bug nets for the additional influx of children coming to the school for safety.

Today that money is available to Titus to go and purchase these items.

We cannot thank you enough as many of you answered the call and gave what you could. May God richly bless your gifts, and may the children see the heart of God in a very tangible way in the help that was provided.

Some of you have said that you are going to send money. If that was your plan and you have not yet done so, then we ask that you please follow through. There will be ongoing needs for the children that were injured. In the Partners in Hope Tanzania budget, money was set aside for an emergency fund. That account has been depleted, and our aim is to help build it back up again.
